1. Pray God's _____.

I John 5:14-15 ***This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. 15 And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him.***

2. Pray for _____.

I Timothy 2:1-2 ***I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people— 2 for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness.***

3. Pray for _____ of others.

I Timothy 2:3-4 ***3 This is good, and pleases God our Savior, 4 who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.***

4. Pray for our own _____.

Matthew 6:11 ***Give us today our daily bread.***

5. Pray for our own _____.

Matthew 6:12-13 ***And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. 13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.***

6. Pray for _____.

Matthew 6:10 ***your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.***

7. Pray for _____.

Ephesians 6:19 ***Pray also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel, 20 for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should.***

Colossians 4:3-4 ***And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. 4 Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should.***
